

Report of Independent Accountants

To the Management of Verified Identity Pass, Inc.:

We have examined the effectiveness of Verified Identity Pass, Inc.'s (VID) controls over personal information collected in its Clear[®] Registered Traveler Program (the Program) to provide reasonable assurance that the personal information was collected, used, retained, and disclosed in conformity with its commitments in its privacy notice and with criteria set forth in Generally Accepted Privacy Principles, issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA) and the Canadian Institute of Chartered Accountants (CICA), and VID's compliance with its commitments in its privacy notice related to the Program during the period December 1, 2006 through June 15, 2007.


VID's management is responsible for maintaining the effectiveness of these controls and for compliance with its commitments in its privacy notice. Our responsibility is to express an opinion based on our examination.

Our examination was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the AICPA and, accordingly, included (1) obtaining an understanding of VID's controls over the privacy of personal information, (2) testing and evaluating the operating effectiveness of the controls, (3) testing compliance with VID's commitments in the privacy notice, and (4) performing such other procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances. We believe that our examination provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

Because of inherent limitations in controls, error or fraud may occur and not be detected. Furthermore, the projection of any conclusions, based on our findings, to future periods is subject to the risk that the validity of such conclusions may be altered because of changes made to the system or controls, the failure to make needed changes to the system or controls, or a deterioration in the degree of effectiveness of the controls.

In our opinion, during the period December 1, 2006 through June 15, 2007, VID, in all material respects:

- maintained effective controls over the privacy of personal information collected in its Clear[®] Registered Traveler Program (the Program) to provide reasonable assurance that the personal information was collected, used, retained, and disclosed in conformity with its commitments in its privacy notice and with criteria set forth in Generally Accepted Privacy Principles, and
- Complied with its commitments in its privacy notice.

Report of Verified Identity Pass, Inc. Management's Privacy Controls over the Clear Registered Traveler Program

At Clear[®], we are deeply committed to the privacy and security rights of our members. We created an extensive privacy policy (http://www.flyclear.com/privacy_fairinfo.html) that outlines the fair handling of member information and have established an array of privacy protection mechanisms. We also established an array of privacy protection mechanisms so you can understand our commitment to the fair handling of information about our members. To actively demonstrate our commitment to these core principles, we undertook an independent, third party examination of our privacy commitments and supporting controls.

Specifically, as the management of the Clear[®] Registered Traveler Program, we are responsible for establishing and maintaining effective controls over the privacy and security of personally identifiable information about our members. The controls that we established have been designed to provide you reasonable assurance that personally identifiable information is protected in conformity with the program's privacy policy. These controls contain monitoring mechanisms, and actions are taken to correct deficiencies identified, if any.

There are inherent limitations in any controls, including the possibility of human error and the circumvention or overriding of controls. Accordingly, even effective controls can provide only reasonable assurance with respect to Clear[®] operations. Furthermore, because of changes in conditions, the effectiveness of controls may vary over time.

Management has assessed the effectiveness of controls over the personal information collected in its Clear[®] Registered Traveler Program. Based on that assessment, in VID Management's opinion, during the period December 1, 2006 through June 15, 2007, VID, in all material respects, has maintained effective controls over its Clear[®] Registered Traveler Program to provide reasonable assurance that:

- personal information was collected, used, retained, and disclosed in conformity with our commitments in our privacy notice and with criteria set forth in Generally Accepted Privacy Principles, and
- complied with our commitments in our privacy notice.
